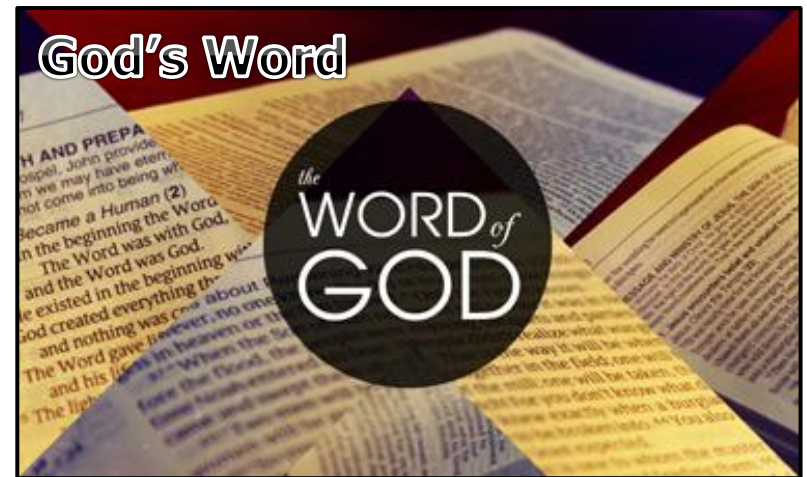




Prayer Station 1: Setting the scene

- Sit quietly and listen to the story of Jesus being tested and watch it unfold before you
- When the story is finished, pick up and feel the symbols and think about which parts of the story they remind you of
- What things about Jesus would you like to follow?
- If there is time, colour in the scene of Jesus in the wilderness. Cut Jesus out and stick him on the scene.
- Pray a prayer asking Jesus to help you follow his example.

Prayer Station 2: The Word of God



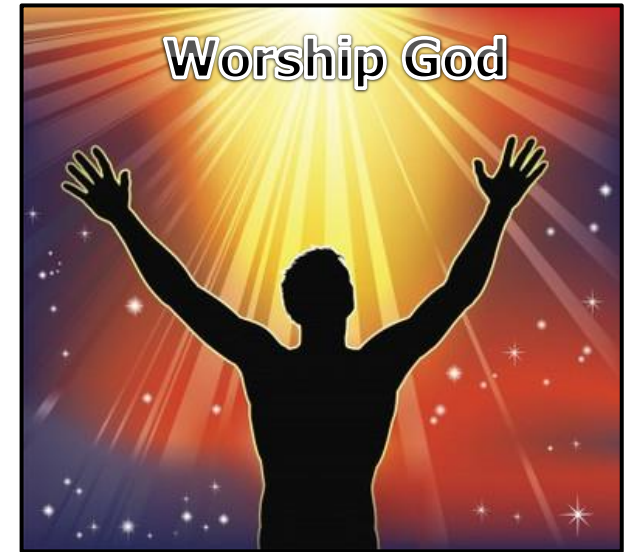
People do not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of God (Deuteronomy 8:3)

The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us (John 1: 14)

- How can we know God's word? Where can we find it?
- When can we read the Bible?
- Look at the different bibles and bible story books. Which do you like best?
- What is your favourite Bible Story? Why is it your favourite?
- Listen to some favourite bible stories read by the worship committee
- Pray a prayer of thanks for the Bible and how God makes himself known to us through the words of the Bible and through Jesus who is called The Word.

Prayer Station 3: Worship

Worship the Lord your God and serve only him
(Deuteronomy 6:13)



- Quietly and without talking, look, touch, smell, the different things that can help us worship
- Think about how they help us worship
- Think about why we don't worship God – what gets in the way sometimes?
- Listen to the music
- Think about how worshipping God makes you feel

- Pray a prayer of worship to God for his love, care, greatness... add your own ideas

Prayer Station 4: Trust

Do not test the Lord your God (Deuteronomy 6:16)
Jesus said, Trust in God, trust also in me
(John 14: 1)

- Look through the papers and magazine and cut out stories or pictures about people in need who you would like to pray for
- Stick your story/picture on the cross, as a way of giving in to Jesus
- Pray a prayer asking God to help in that situation
