The Scaled Score was introduced for the first time in 2016. This standardises the test results with 100 being the standard for achieving the Expected Standard for the end of Key Stage. 110 is considered the score required to demonstrate Higher Attainment.

The Progress Score is the difference between each child's KS2 attainment and the National average KS2 attainment for their prior attainment group from KS1.

E.g. For a child achieving 2A in reading at KS1, their KS2 Scaled Score is compared with the average score of all children nationally achieving 2As at KS1 and this difference then becomes their Progress Score. These scores are then averaged for each school to give an Average Progress Score.

The National Progress scores are therefore 0.0 and you can see if the school has better progress than nationally by the distance above or below zero.
